I. Broad Theme:

Digital Education and Artificial Intelligence (AI)

Any of the below-listed sub-themes may be chosen by the participants for submission, apart from these, any other related themes are also allowed as long as the Broad theme is followed.

2. Categories:

- A. **EduToon (Cartoon)** - JPEG/PDF (Upload size - HD preferably 2 MB & above): Original drawing, sketch, or illustration on the theme of Digital Education and Artificial Intelligence (AI), online learning, education technology, etc. – Sub theme is:
- i. **Digital Education: Bridging Gaps in Remote Learning:** The impact of digital tools on remote and rural education.
 - ii. **The Future of Classrooms with AI Integration:** How AI reshapes traditional teaching methods.
 - iii. **Challenges and Ethics of AI in Education:** Balancing innovation with data privacy and bias concerns.
 - iv. **Teacher: AI Collaboration:** How AI supports teachers, not replaces them.
 - v. **The Future of Hybrid Learning:** Exploring the blend of digital and in-person education.
- B. **EduWrite (Articles)** - PDF (Word limit: 900-1200 words): Original educational articles on the theme of Artificial Intelligence (AI) in Digital Education, online education, and other related topics of interest.
- i. **Imagining the Future Classroom:** AI-powered learning spaces of the future.
 - ii. **Digital Education Across the Globe:** How digital education reaches students worldwide.
 - iii. **Learning Without Borders:** Depicting how digital education makes learning accessible everywhere.
 - iv. **AI and Creativity:** How AI helps students explore creative fields (e.g., art, music).
 - v. **A Day in the Life of a Digital Student:** Illustrating how students interact with digital learning tools.
