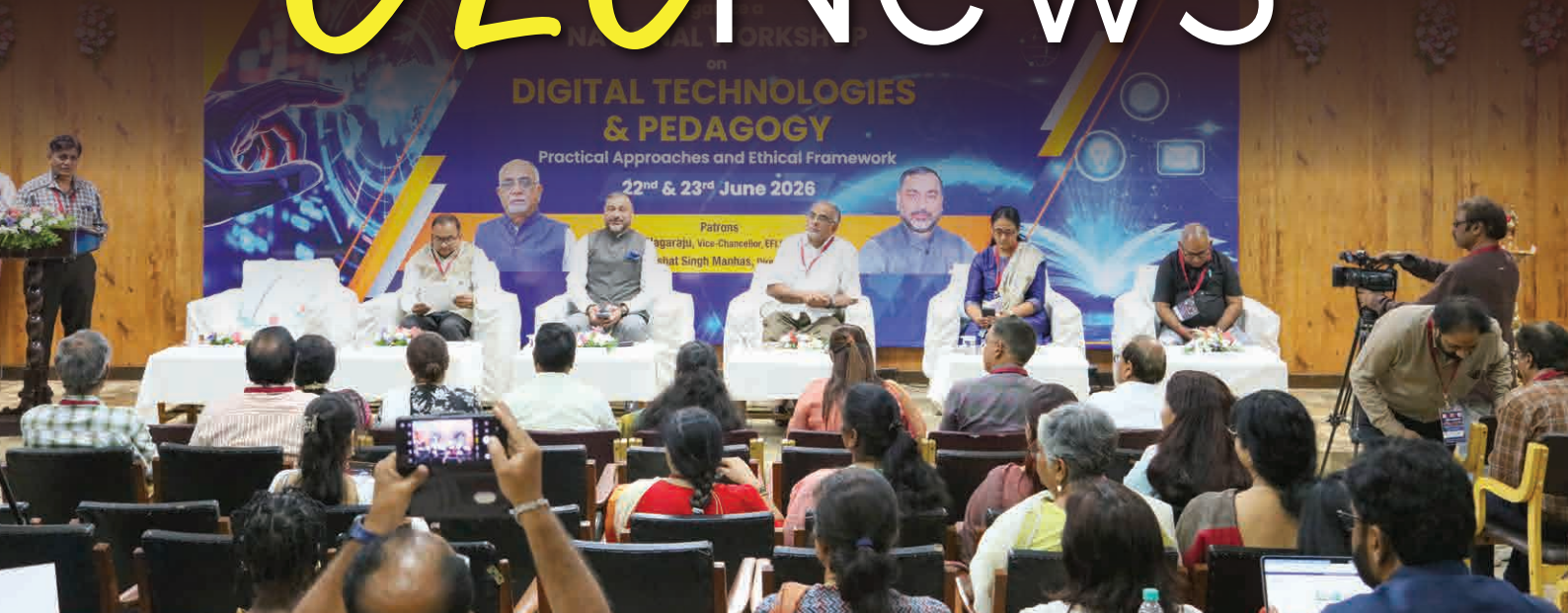

BRIDGING THE DIVIDE: FROM SITE TO SWAYAM PRABHA TOWARDS VIKSIT BHARAT @2047

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India's story of using television for education is one of vision, determination, and remarkable progress. It is a journey that began in the dusty villages of the 1970s and is now hurtling toward the digital dream of Viksit Bharat @2047. At the heart of this transformation lies the vision of one man, the brilliance of an institution, and a series of "firsts" that changed the world's perception of what a developing nation could achieve.. This journey highlights the contributions of the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) and the forward-thinking vision of Dr. Vikram Sarabhai, the father of India's space programme. It perfectly aligns with the goal of Viksit Bharat (Developed India) by 2047.

The Visionary Beginning: Dr. Vikram Sarabhai and SITE (1975-76)

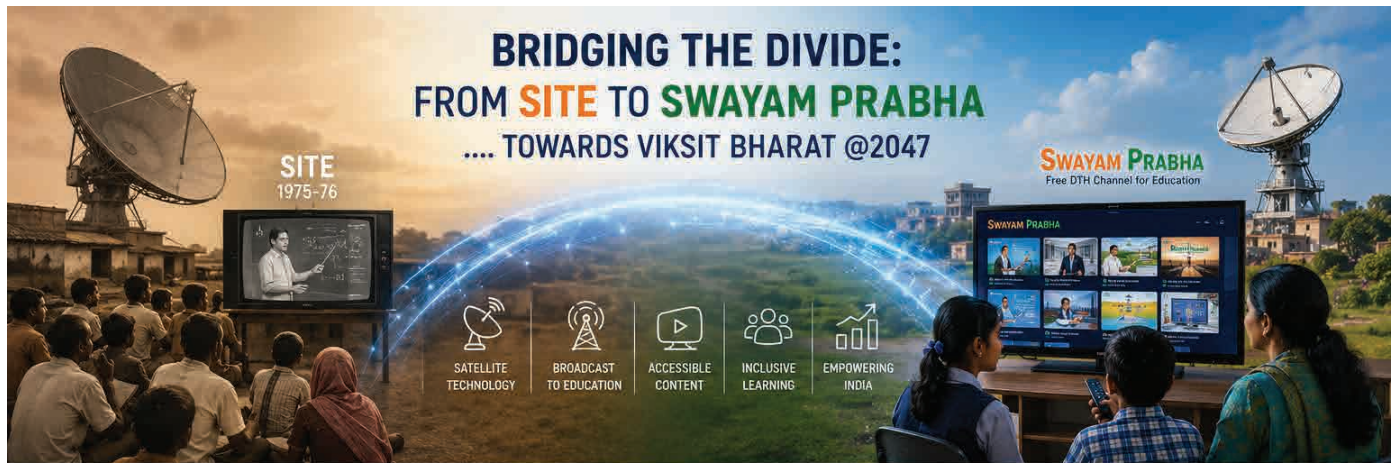
Dr. Vikram Sarabhai believed space technology should serve people, especially in education and development, rather than just military or prestige purposes. He saw satellites as tools to connect India's vast rural areas with knowledge and progress. He famously stated that India did not have the "ambition of conquering the moon," but rather the urgent need to use advanced technology to solve the "real problems of man and society." In the late 1960s, he worked with NASA to launch one of the world's largest satellite-based education experiments.

The **Satellite Instructional Television Experiment (SITE)** started on 1 August 1975 and ran for one year. NASA provided its ATS-6 satellite, positioned over India. The project reached more than 2,400 villages across six states: Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Orissa (now Odisha), and Rajasthan. These were mostly backward, remote areas where many villages lacked electricity.

Special community TV sets, some powered by batteries or solar cells, were placed in schools or village centres. Programmes covered agriculture, health, family planning, national integration, and school education for children and teachers. Content was produced in local languages like Hindi, Kannada, Oriya, and Telugu to make it relatable.

SITE was called "the largest sociological experiment in the world." It proved that satellite TV could deliver education and information directly to rural India. Thousands of teachers received training, and villagers learned better farming methods and health practices. Though it was an experiment, it developed strong technical skills in India and demonstrated the significant potential of space technology for social good.

Dr. Sarabhai's dream was clear: use advanced technology to bridge the gap between rich and poor, urban and rural. His ideas laid the foundation for



everything that followed, even though he passed away in 1971 before SITE fully launched.

The Goal: To provide educational programs on health, family planning, and agriculture to 2,400 villages across six Indian states.

The Technology: Using the American ATS-6 satellite, ISRO managed the ground segment, setting up community TV sets in areas that often-lacked reliable electricity.

The Impact: For the first time, a farmer in Rajasthan and a student in Odisha could watch the same high-quality instructional content. It proved that satellite technology could be a powerful "classroom in the sky."

Building on Success: INSAT and National Reach

The lessons from SITE helped India develop its own satellite system. In 1982, the Indian National Satellite System (INSAT) began. These multi-purpose satellites provided TV broadcasting, telecommunications, weather forecasting, and educational content across the country. In the 1980s, the launch of the Indian National Satellite (INSAT) system revolutionised broadcasting. It enabled a nationwide "countrywide classroom" through the University Grants Commission (UGC).

INSAT made television more common in India. Educational programmes started reaching wider audiences through Doordarshan. It was a big step from the limited one-year experiment of SITE to regular, nationwide services. ISRO continued to improve satellite technology, making signals stronger and coverage better.

A Dedicated Leap: EDUSAT (2004)

In September 2004, India achieved another milestone by launching EDUSAT (GSAT-3) — the world's first satellite built exclusively for education. This showed India's growing confidence in space technology.

EDUSAT supported interactive distance education. It had special transponders for Ku-band and C-band, allowing virtual classrooms. Schools, colleges, and training centres used Satellite Interactive Terminals (SITs) for live lectures and two-way communication. It was especially useful for remote areas, medical education, and teacher training.

EDUSAT served for several years and strengthened India's capability in using satellites for learning. It was built on Sarabhai's vision by making education more interactive and accessible.

The Modern Era: Swayam Prabha Free DTH

Today, the journey has reached an exciting level with Swayam Prabha. Launched in 2017 by the Ministry of Education in partnership with ISRO, it is a group of 40 (now significantly expanded, with reports of 280+ channels in some contexts under PM e-Vidya) free Direct-to-Home (DTH) educational channels that broadcast 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

These channels use the GSAT-15 satellite and cover school education (Classes 1-12), higher education, vocational skills, competitive exams, and more. Content comes from top institutions like NCERT, NPTEL, IITs, UGC-CEC, and IGNOU. Programmes are available in multiple languages and are completely free — no internet needed. This is perfect for rural, tribal, and remote areas where online access is limited.

Swayam Prabha brings high-quality lectures, tutorials, and educational content directly into homes. During the COVID-19 pandemic, it played a key role under the PM e-Vidya initiative, along with "One Class, One Channel" for school students. It has reduced the digital divide and made learning possible anytime, anywhere. The future isn't just for school children. As the economy changes, millions of adults will need to reskill. Educational DTH will serve as a massive "Skill University," providing vocational training and certification in local languages to empower the workforce.

ISRO's Outstanding Contribution

Throughout this journey, ISRO has been the backbone. From building expertise during SITE, to launching INSAT series, EDUSAT, and supporting Swayam Prabha, ISRO has developed reliable, cost-effective satellites tailored for India's needs. Indian scientists and engineers have mastered complex technologies, making India self-reliant in space.

ISRO's work goes beyond hardware. It focuses on social impact — using space for development. This "Sarabhai spirit" of applying science for people's welfare continues today.

Envisioning Viksit Bharat @2047

As India aims to become a developed nation by 2047 — the centenary of Independence — education is at the heart of this vision. Viksit Bharat needs 100% literacy, high-quality skills, innovation, and equal opportunities for all.

Educational TV can play a big role here. Future steps could include:

- More channels and higher-quality, interactive content using advanced satellites.
- Better integration with SWAYAM online platform,

DIKSHA, and mobile apps for blended learning.

- Stronger focus on vocational skills, AI, coding, sustainability, and Indian knowledge systems as per NEP 2020.
- Reaching every corner, including remote islands and hilly areas, with reliable DTH and community viewing.
- Using new technologies like higher-resolution broadcasts, personalised learning, and virtual reality where possible.
- Public-private partnerships to create even more relevant local-language content.

By 2047, every Indian child and adult should have easy access to world-class education through multiple channels — TV, the internet, and mobile. Satellite-based education can help achieve equity, making sure no one is left behind because of location or economic status.

A Journey Worth Celebrating

From SITE's humble community TVs in 2,400 villages to Swayam Prabha's 24x7 free channels reaching millions, India's educational TV journey is inspiring. It shows how one man's vision — Dr. Vikram Sarabhai's — combined with ISRO's dedication and government support, can transform a nation.

From the experimental black-and-white screens of SITE in 1975 to the 40 high-definition channels of Swayamprabha, India has shown the world how to democratize knowledge.

This is not just a story of technology. It is a story of hope, inclusion, and empowerment. As India marches towards Viksit Bharat, this wonderful journey reminds us that space technology, when used wisely, can light up lives and build a brighter future for all.

सीईसी निदेशक की एजेके एमसीआरसी से पारस्परिक सुदृढ़ीकरण की पहल पर जामिया मिल्लिया इस्लामिया के कुलपति से भेंटवार्ता

शैक्षिक संचार संकाय (सीईसी) के निदेशक आचार्य परिक्षित सिंह मनहास ने 17 जून, 2026 को जामिया मिल्लिया इस्लामिया परिसर में विश्वविद्यालय के कुलपति आचार्य मजहर आसिफ से शिष्टाचार भेंट की। इस बैठक में शैक्षिक नवाचार, डिजिटल शिक्षण संसाधनों के विस्तार तथा इन क्षेत्रों में गुणवत्ता संवर्धन से संबंधित विषयों पर विस्तृत चर्चा की गई। दोनों शिक्षाविदों ने ई-लर्निंग संसाधनों के विकास तथा विद्यार्थियों के लिए प्रौद्योगिकी-सक्षम गुणवत्तापूर्ण शिक्षा सुनिश्चित करने के उपायों पर विचार-विमर्श किया। विशेष रूप से, सीईसी के अधीन कार्यरत जामिया मिल्लिया इस्लामिया के ए.जे.के. जनसंचार अनुसंधान केंद्र (एजेके एमसीआरसी) को और अधिक सशक्त बनाने पर बल दिया गया। यह केंद्र देश के अग्रणी शैक्षिक मीडिया संस्थानों में से एक है तथा पिछले दो दशकों से अधिक समय से उच्च गुणवत्ता वाली शैक्षिक सामग्री के निर्माण में सीईसी का महत्वपूर्ण सहयोगी रहा है। वर्ष 1982 में स्थापित एमसीआरसी ने विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग के अंतर्गत सीईसी के लिए 1,000 से अधिक शैक्षिक कार्यक्रमों का निर्माण किया है। सीईसी के साथ इसकी दीर्घकालिक सहभागिता देशभर के विद्यार्थियों के लिए उद्देश्यपरक गुणवत्तापूर्ण शैक्षिक सामग्री उपलब्ध कराने की पहल को दर्शाती है।

यह संवाद नवाचार-आधारित एवं भविष्य उन्मुख शिक्षा प्रोत्साहन एवं डिजिटल शिक्षा, संसाधनों को नई दिशा प्रदान करने की दृष्टि से महत्वपूर्ण माना जा रहा है, जिससे विद्यार्थियों को राष्ट्रीय डिजिटल मंचों- स्वयं एवं स्वयं प्रभा का लाभ प्राप्त होगा।

Strengthening Ties: CEC Director Meets AJK MCRC Leadership at Jamia Millia Islamia

Prof. Parikshat Singh Manhas, Director, CEC, met Prof. Mazhar Asif, Vice-Chancellor, Jamia Millia Islamia, on 17th June 2026 at the university campus. The meeting focused on educational innovation, the expansion of digital learning resources, and the enhancement of quality in these areas. Both academicians held detailed discussions on developing e-learning resources and ensuring technology-enabled, quality education for students. Special emphasis was placed on further strengthening the A.J.K. Mass Communication Research Centre (AJK MCRC), Jamia Millia Islamia, under the aegis of CEC, which serves as a leading centre and has been a key partner in producing high-quality educational content for over two decades. Founded in 1982, the MCRC has produced over 1,000 educational programmes for CEC under the University Grants Commission. Its longstanding collaboration with CEC reflects a shared vision advancing quality educational content for students across the country.

The interaction is expected to provide a new direction to the production of future-oriented, innovative digital education resources, enabling students to benefit from national digital platforms like SWAYAM and SWAYAM Prabha.

सीईसी के जागरूकता अभियान से मूक्स की देशभर में गम्यता का विस्तारण

शैक्षिक संचार संकाय (सीईसी) ने जुलाई-दिसम्बर, 2026 सत्र से पूर्व सीईसी मूक्स पाठ्यक्रमों के प्रति जागरूकता बढ़ाने के उद्देश्य से देशव्यापी जनसंपर्क कार्यक्रम के अंतर्गत ऑनलाइन कार्यशालाओं की श्रृंखला आयोजित की है। जून माह के दौरान सीईसी ने अपने 20 शैक्षिक मीडिया अनुसंधान केंद्रों (ईएमआरसी) तथा विभिन्न उच्च शिक्षण संस्थानों के सहयोग से देशभर के शिक्षाविदों को जोड़ने का प्रयास किया। यह पहल दिल्ली से असम तथा जम्मू से चैनई तक विस्तारित रही। इस अभियान का शुभारंभ 3 जून को दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय के विवेकानंद कॉलेज से हुआ। इसके पश्चात 5 जून को जम्मू विश्वविद्यालय के साथ एक व्यापक सत्र आयोजित किया गया, जिसमें 100 से अधिक शिक्षाविदों ने सहभागिता की। इस अवसर पर आगामी सत्र के लिए प्रस्तावित सीईसी के 172 मूक्स पाठ्यक्रमों की जानकारीयां साझा की गई।

प्रत्येक कार्यशाला का उद्घाटन डॉ. सुनील मेहडू, संयुक्त निदेशक (सॉफ्टवेयर), सीईसी के द्वारा किया गया। उन्होंने प्रतिभागियों को भारत में डिजिटल शिक्षा के उपादानों एवं शिक्षण-पद्धतियों के प्रसार हेतु सीईसी के सतत प्रयासों से अवगत कराया। इसके उपरांत सीईसी की उपलब्धियों पर शो-रील प्रस्तुत की गई। सीईसी के अधिकारियों एवं मूक्स समन्वयकों द्वारा मूक्स की महत्ता, उपयोगिता एवं व्यापक पहुँच पर आधारित एक विस्तृत प्रस्तुति दी गई। इसके बाद संयोजक संस्थानों से संबद्ध वरिष्ठ प्रतिनिधियों ने अपने विचार व्यक्त किए तथा पाठ्यक्रम विकास, क्रेडिट अंतरण और नामांकन संबंधी विषयों पर शिक्षाविदों के साथ संवादात्मक चर्चा आयोजित की गई।

यह अभियान ईएमआरसी लखनऊ के सहयोग से 10 जून को बाबासाहेब भीमराव अंबेडकर विश्वविद्यालय में आयोजित कार्यशाला के साथ आगे बढ़ा, जहाँ ईएमआरसी लखनऊ के निदेशक आचार्य. गोपाल सिंह ने प्रतिभागियों को संबोधित किया। इसके पश्चात 11 जून को डिब्रूगढ़ विश्वविद्यालय में आयोजित सत्र में 90 से अधिक शिक्षाविदों ने भाग लिया। इस कार्यक्रम का संचालन सीईसी अधिकारियों तथा ईएमआरसी डिब्रूगढ़ के निदेशक आचार्य मृदुल बारदोलोई ने किया। 12 जून को दो महत्वपूर्ण कार्यशालाएँ आयोजित की गईं। पहली कार्यशाला डॉ. हरीसिंह गौर विश्वविद्यालय में ईएमआरसी सागर के सहयोग से आयोजित हुई, जिसमें ईएमआरसी सागर के निदेशक डॉ. पंकज तिवारी ने अपने विचार साझा किए। दूसरी कार्यशाला उस्मानिया विश्वविद्यालय, हैदराबाद में आयोजित की गई, जिसमें कुलपति आचार्य. कुमार मोलुगारम ने विशेष रूप से सहभागिता की। उन्होंने सीईसी के प्रयासों की सराहना की तथा शिक्षा में कृत्रिम बुद्धिमत्ता (आर्टिफिशियल इंटेलिजेंस) की बढ़ती भूमिका पर आयोजित चर्चा में भी भाग लिया। इसी कड़ी में कोलकाता के सेंट जेवियर्स कॉलेज में आयोजित कार्यशाला में 40 शिक्षाविदों सहित महाविद्यालय के प्राचार्य रेव. डॉ. डोमिनिक सैवियो ने सहभागिता की। उक्त दिवस को ईएमआरसी रुड़की में आयोजित कार्यशाला में निदेशक डॉ. श्रुति भारद्वाज ने प्रतिभागियों के साथ कार्यान्वयन संबंधी चुनौतियों पर विस्तृत संवाद किया।

आगामी दिनों में संपर्क एवं प्रसार अभियान का अधिक व्यापक स्तर पर संचालन जारी है। 16 जून को दो कार्यशालाओं का समानांतर आयोजन किया गया। पहली कार्यशाला ईएमआरसी मद्रुरै के सहयोग से मद्रुरै कामराज विश्वविद्यालय में आयोजित हुई, जिसमें ईएमआरसी मद्रुरै के निदेशक श्री ए. मुप्पल ने नामांकन पंजीकरण बढ़ाने के संबंध में महत्वपूर्ण सुझाव प्रस्तुत किए। दूसरी कार्यशाला ईएमआरसी पुदुच्चेरी के सहयोग से पुदुच्चेरी विश्वविद्यालय में आयोजित की गई, जहाँ 30 शिक्षाविद् ईएमआरसी पुदुच्चेरी के निदेशक प्रो. एम. एस. मोहम्मद हनीफ के साथ संवादात्मक-सत्र में सम्मिलित हुए। 18 जून को ईएमआरसी इंदौर ने सीईसी के सहयोग से देवी अहिल्या विश्वविद्यालय के 60 प्रतिभागियों के लिए कार्यशाला आयोजित की। इस अवसर पर ईएमआरसी इंदौर के निदेशक डॉ. चंदन गुप्ता ने राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति (एनईपी) 2020 के अंतर्गत वर्ष 2035 तक 50 प्रतिशत सकल नामांकन अनुपात (ग्रॉस एनरोलमेन्ट रेश्यो- जीईआर) के लक्ष्य की प्राप्ति में मूक्स पाठ्यक्रम की भूमिका पर प्रकाश डाला। उन्होंने भारतीय ज्ञान परंपरा तथा कृत्रिम बुद्धिमत्ता (आर्टिफिशियल इंटेलिजेंस) जैसे विषयों पर नए पाठ्यक्रम विकसित करने के लिए भी प्रतिभागियों को प्रोत्साहित किया। इसी क्रम में ईएमआरसी अहमदाबाद के सहयोग से गुजरात विश्वविद्यालय में आयोजित कार्यशाला में 90 प्रतिभागियों ने सहभागिता की। कार्यक्रम के दौरान वर्ष 1984 से अब तक 500 से अधिक पाठ्यक्रमों के निर्माण में ईएमआरसी अहमदाबाद की उल्लेखनीय विरासत एवं योगदान को रेखांकित किया गया।

इन कार्यशालाओं की श्रृंखला सीईसी की डिजिटल शिक्षा के क्षेत्र में निरंतर विस्तृत होती भूमिका को रेखांकित करती है। मौजूदा समय में सीईसी द्वारा स्वयं प्लेटफॉर्म पर 700 से अधिक मूक्स तथा 2,000 से अधिक पाठ्यक्रम उपलब्ध कराए हैं। इन पहलों के परिणामस्वरूप अब तक 46 लाख से अधिक विद्यार्थियों का नामांकन तथा 1.6 लाख से अधिक क्रेडिट प्रमाण-पत्र प्रदान किए जा चुके हैं। सीईसी देशभर के शिक्षार्थियों के लिए विभिन्न भारतीय भाषाओं में पाठ्यक्रमों के अनुवाद एवं विकास का कार्य भी सक्रिय रूप से कर रहा है। यह पहल गुणवत्तापूर्ण उच्च शिक्षा की व्यापक पहुँच सुनिश्चित करने के प्रति सीईसी की प्रतिबद्धता को दर्शाती है।

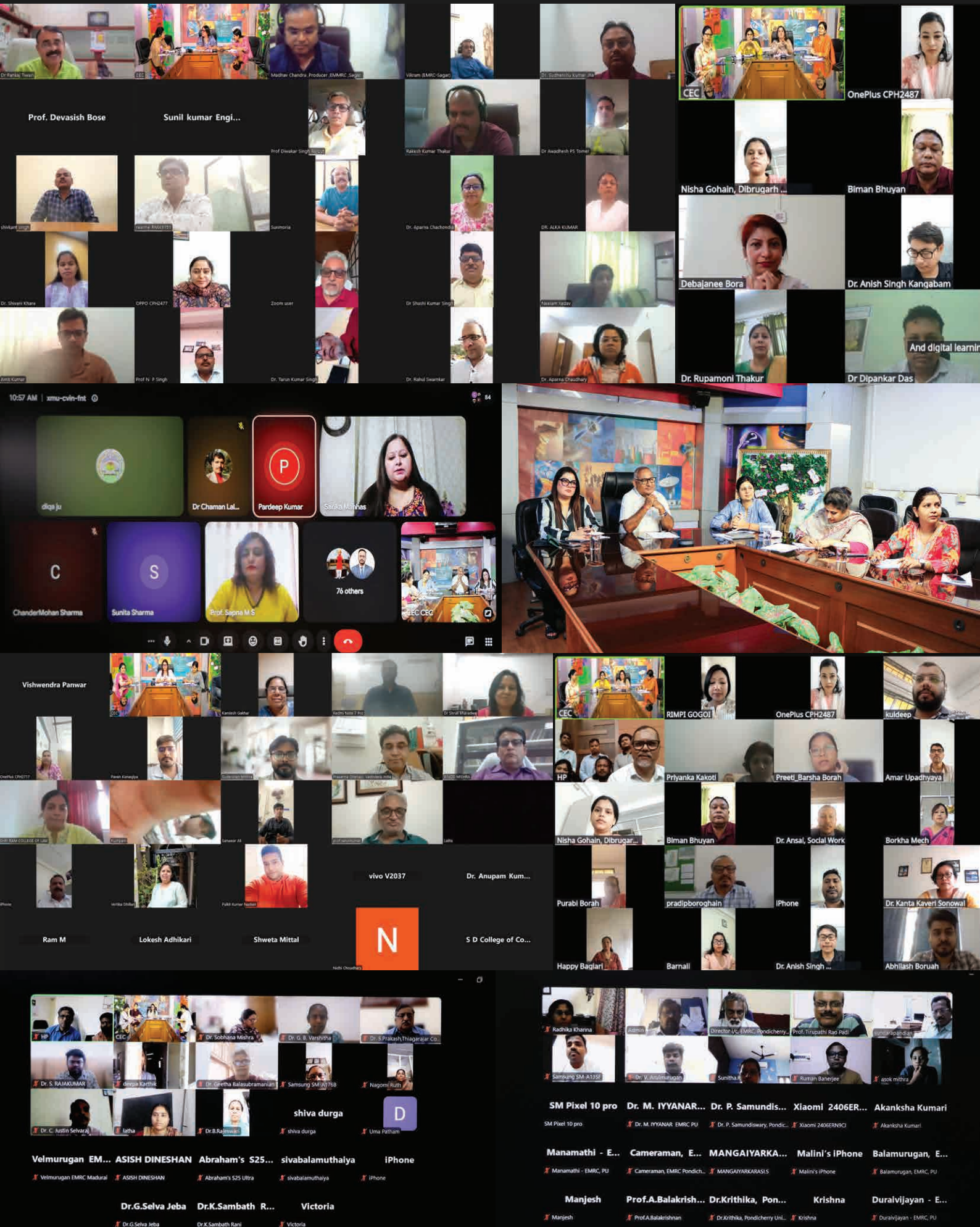

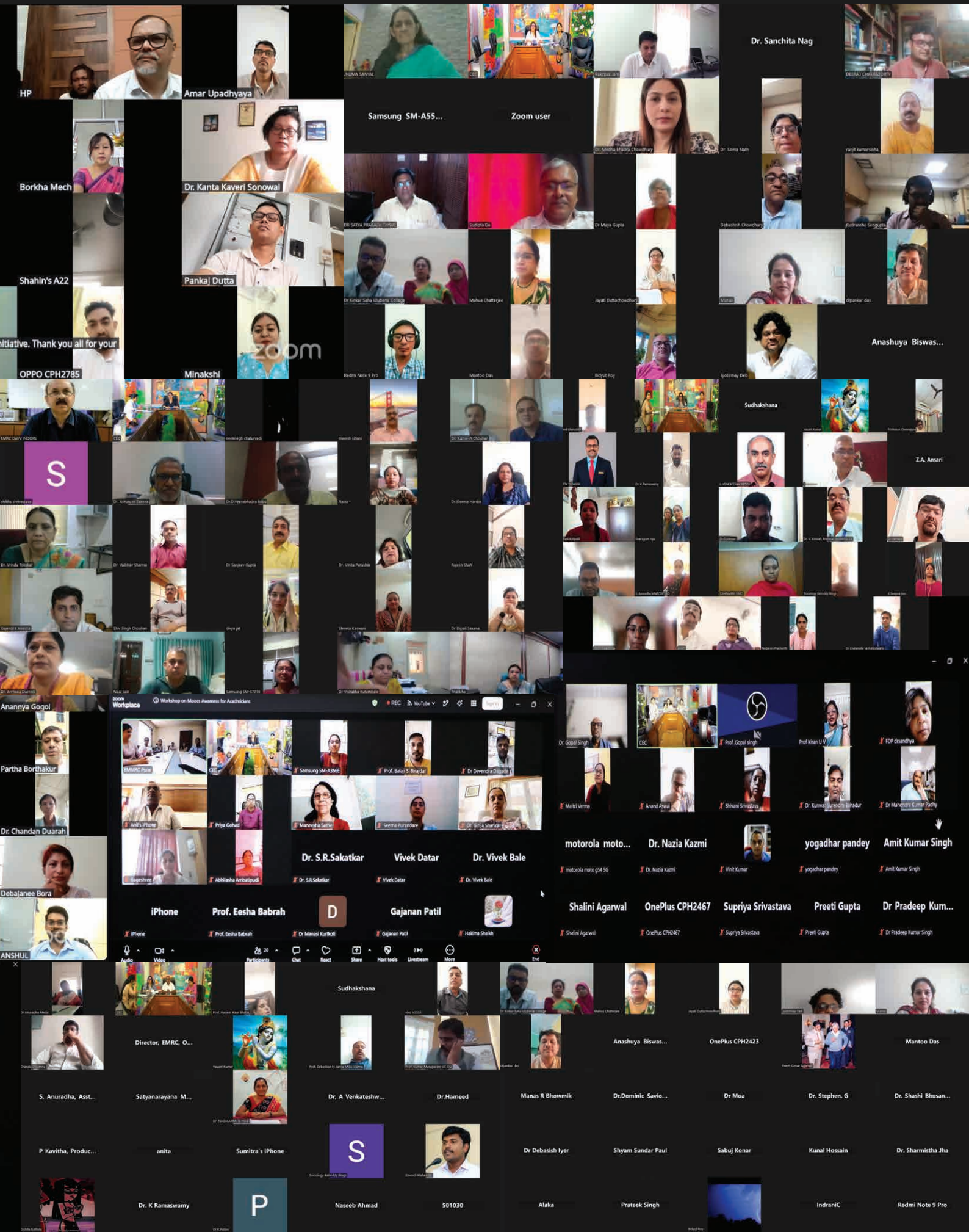

CEC's Outreach Drive Takes MOOCs Awareness Across the Country

The Consortium for Educational Communication (CEC) conducted a nationwide Outreach Programme with a series of online workshops to raise awareness of CEC MOOCs ahead of the July-December 2026 semester. Throughout June, CEC worked in close collaboration with its network of 20 Educational Media Research Centres (EMRCs) and higher education institutes to engage academicians across institutions spanning the length and breadth of the country, from Delhi to Assam and from Jammu to Chennai. The drive commenced with Vivekananda College, University of Delhi, on June 3, followed by a large-scale session with the University of Jammu on June 5, which drew over 100 academicians and highlighted CEC's 172 MOOCs lined up for the upcoming semester.

Each workshop was opened by Dr Sunil Mehru, Joint Director (SW), CEC, who apprised the participants of CEC's endeavours to promote Digital Education tools and pedagogy across India, followed by a screening of CEC's showreel. A detailed presentation was prepared by CEC staff members and MOOC coordinators for attendees on the significance and reach of Massive Open Online Courses, followed by remarks from the host institution's leadership and an open exchange with academics on course development, credit transfer, and enrolment.

The momentum carried into Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar University, in collaboration with EMRC Lucknow, on June 10, where Prof. Gopal Singh, Director, EMRC Lucknow, addressed participants, followed by Dibrugarh University on June 11, where more than 90 academicians joined a session led by CEC officials and Prof. Mridul Bordoloi, Director, EMRC Dibrugarh. Mid-month saw two workshops on June 12: one with Dr Harisingh Gour Vishwavidyalaya in collaboration with EMRC Sagar, where Dr Pankaj Tiwari, Director, EMRC Sagar, shared his insights, and another with Osmania University, Hyderabad, notably graced by Vice-Chancellor Prof. Kumar Molugaram, who commended CEC's efforts and joined a discussion that also touched on the growing role of Artificial Intelligence in education. The series continued with workshops at St. Xavier's College, Kolkata, attended by 40 academicians and the Principal, Rev. Dr Dominic Savio, and at EMRC Roorkee the same day, where the Director, Dr Shruti Bharadwaj, actively engaged with participants on implementation challenges.

The outreach campaign extended further in the days that followed. On June 16, workshops were held simultaneously with Madurai Kamaraj University in collaboration with EMRC Madurai, where Sh. A. Muppai, Director, EMRC Madurai, offered suggestions on improving enrolment, and with the University of Pondicherry in collaboration with EMRC Pondicherry, where 30 academicians engaged with Prof. M.S. Mohammad Haneef, Director, EMRC Pondicherry. On June 18, EMRC Indore partnered with CEC for a workshop with 60 participants from Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya, where Dr Chandan Gupta, Director, EMRC Indore, spoke on the role of MOOCs in achieving the NEP 2020 target of 50 per cent Gross Enrolment Ratio by 2035 and encouraged development of new courses in Indian Knowledge Systems and Artificial Intelligence. Gujarat University, in collaboration with EMRC Ahmedabad, drew 90 participants and highlighted EMRC Ahmedabad's legacy of over 500 courses since 1984.

Collectively, these workshops highlight CEC's expanding footprint in digital education, showcasing a catalogue of over 700 MOOCs and 2,000-plus courses delivered on SWAYAM, and engagement that has driven more than 46 lakh student enrolments and over 1.6 lakh credit certificates to date. CEC is also actively translating and preparing courses in several Indian languages for learners across India, to widen access to quality higher education nationwide.

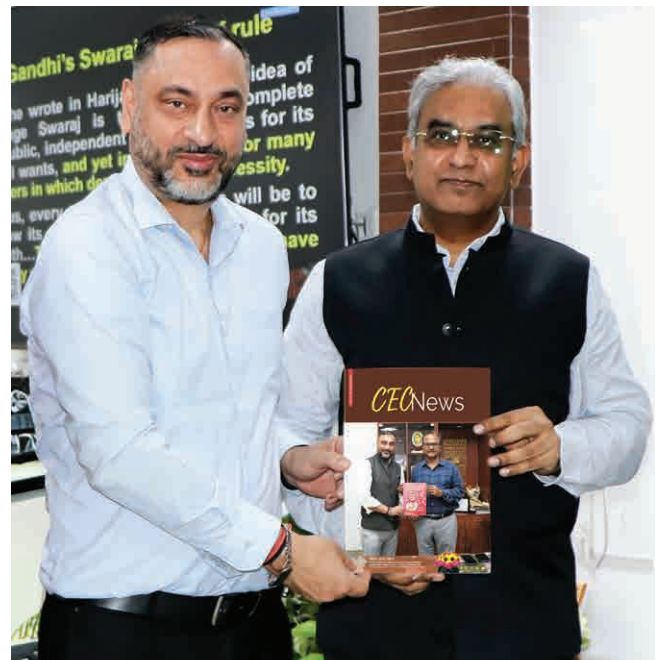
सीईसी में सेमका निदेशक के आगमन से सहयोग की नई यात्रा का आशान्वित आरंभ

The keynote address on “Pedagogy in the Digital Age: Need to Recalibrate” was delivered by Prof. G. B. Reddy, Vice-Chancellor, National University of Advanced Legal Studies (NUALS), Kochi.

In his inaugural address, Prof. Manhas observed that the rapid advancement of artificial intelligence is transforming the educational landscape in unprecedented ways. From teaching and learning to assessment and academic administration, AI is reshaping pedagogical practices, creating new opportunities while simultaneously raising important ethical concerns. He noted that the workshop aims to provide participants with a comprehensive understanding of these developments and equip them with the practical skills and critical perspectives needed to integrate AI into educational contexts.

In his presidential remarks, Prof. Nagaraju highlighted the growing importance of digital technologies in higher education and emphasised the need for educational institutions to engage proactively with emerging AI tools while maintaining a strong commitment to academic values, critical thinking, and ethical responsibility. Delivering the keynote address, Prof. G. B. Reddy reflected on the changing nature of pedagogy in the digital era and argued for recalibrating educational approaches to meet the demands of rapidly evolving technological environments.

The inaugural session was attended by Prof. T. T. Sreekumar, Director i/c, EMRC, EFLU; Ms. Sini Manchala, Registrar, EFLU; and Dr. Sunil Mehru, Joint Director (SW), Consortium for Educational Communication, along with faculty members, researchers, and participants from various institutions. Over the course of two days, the workshop addressed a wide range of themes including learner engagement in online and hybrid classrooms, the use of AI in blended learning environments, digital assessment practices, the pedagogical integration of AI tools, and practical strategies for implementing AI-enabled educational technologies in teaching, curriculum design, instructional planning, and learner support systems. The workshop brought together teachers, researchers, and educational practitioners to explore the opportunities and challenges presented by artificial intelligence in contemporary education. It concluded with a valedictory session that provided an opportunity to reflect on key insights, learning outcomes, and future directions for AI-enabled pedagogy in higher education.

Orientation Programme on Design and Development of SWAYAM MOOCs organised by EMRC EFLU

Dr Supriya Sakamuri, Producer, MOOCs Coordinator, and SPOC, SWAYAM MOOCs, EMRC, EFLU, conducted an orientation programme on the design and development of e-content for SWAYAM MOOCs at RBVRR Women's College, Hyderabad, on 6th June 2026. During the orientation programme, participants were introduced to the UGC four-quadrant approach to MOOC development, which forms the pedagogical framework for SWAYAM courses. The first quadrant consists of e-tutorials in the form of video lectures and presentations. The second quadrant includes e-content such as reading materials, study guides, and supplementary resources. The third quadrant focuses on self-assessment through quizzes, assignments, and tests to reinforce learning. The fourth quadrant provides discussion forums and interactive platforms that facilitate learner engagement, clarification of doubts, and peer-to-peer interaction. Faculty members gained practical insights into integrating these four components to design effective, learner-centric MOOCs. About 60 faculty members participated in the programme and learned how to develop MOOCs for SWAYAM.

Dr. Surbhi Uniyal is an Assistant Professor of Philosophy at Jindal Global Business School, O.P. Jindal Global University. She holds a PhD in Philosophy from Jawaharlal Nehru University, where she specialised in Philosophy of Mind and Ethics. She also completed her M.A. and M.Phil. in Philosophy from Jawaharlal Nehru University and earned her B.A. (Hons.) in Philosophy from Gargi College, University of Delhi. Prior to joining O.P. Jindal Global University, Dr. Uniyal served as Assistant Professor at Bennett University and Manipal University Jaipur. She has also taught as a Guest Faculty at Hansraj College, University of Delhi. In addition, she delivers live philosophy lectures for CEC, contributing to national-level higher education initiatives. At Jindal Global Business School, Dr. Uniyal teaches the Philosophy of Business and Critical Thinking course to business students. Dr. Uniyal's research lies at the intersection of Philosophy of Mind, Ethics, and emerging technologies. Her work critically engages with the Extended Mind Hypothesis, examining how cognitive processes increasingly integrate with external tools. She explores the ethical and conceptual implications of AI-human integration, particularly how technologically mediated cognition reshapes traditional notions of agency, autonomy, moral responsibility, and personhood.

Overview of the series

Philosophy trains the capacity for clear conceptual and critical thinking. Philosophical reasoning equips one to handle genuinely hard problems, problems that have no algorithmic solution. Many of the most consequential business decisions involve competing goods, irreducible uncertainty, and moral trade-offs. These problems require the discipline of practical reason, which philosophy teaches. Philosophy can also be understood as the foundation for professional integrity. A person trained in philosophical thinking is better equipped to question assumptions, recognise ethical dilemmas, and take responsibility for their choices, not because philosophy guarantees good behaviour, but because it encourages deeper awareness of what is at stake in every decision.

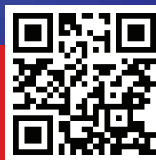
The lecture discusses a set of foundational philosophical tools including critical thinking, the Socratic method, and thought experiments and examines their direct relevance to commercial and organisational life. It highlights how these tools sharpen decision-making, challenge unexamined assumptions, and build a culture of reasoned, accountable professional practice. It also discusses the major normative ethical frameworks consequentialism, Kantian deontology, and virtue ethics and their importance as lenses for evaluating commercial decisions. It highlights that leadership is not merely a management technique; it is a philosophical question about the relationship between a person in authority and those they are responsible for.

Learning Objectives

- To understand and articulate why philosophical reasoning is indispensable to business decision-making and professional integrity.
- To apply core philosophical tools like critical thinking, the Socratic method, and thought experiments to real-world organisational dilemmas.
- To evaluate commercial and managerial decisions through the lenses of consequentialism, Kantian deontology, and Aristotelian virtue ethics.
