DIGITAL EDUCATION CHANGING NATURE OF EDUCATION IN CURRENT SCENARIO



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o re-envision education, the Ministry of Education had released the “India Report 2020” on Digital Education (MoE) on 28th July, 2020. The report provided a detailed account of the innovative methods adopted by the MoE and the Education Departments of the States and Union Territories to ensure accessible and inclusive education for children at home to remove barriers to learning.

According to the report, the government has viewed education as a comprehensive programme which aims to universalize digital education across a wide spectrum of schools from pre-nursery to senior secondary classes. In the current context of globalization, quality digital education has acquired a new relevance. In order to help teachers, scholars, and students with disabilities, the MoE has initiated several projects in this context like: Diksha Manch, SWAYAM Prabha DTH Channels, SWAYAM MOOCs, On Air- ShikshaVani, NIOS Daisy, e-Pathshala, National Repository of Open Educational Resources (NROER)

for Individuals, e-learning webportals, webinars, distribution of e-books, chat groups initiatives etc. Further, the Central and State Governments and Union Territory Governments have also done important work in providing digital education to the students by using social media tools like WhatsApp groups, YouTube channels, online classes, Google Meet, e-learning portals with Sky TV (Doordarshan and Regional channels), Radio and DIKSHA as some of the major media to connect with students in which the use of DIKSHA was the most prominent choice of all stakeholders.

A few of the major digital education initiatives by state governments are: “SMILE” (Social Media Interface for Learning Engagement) in Rajasthan, “Project Home Classes” in Jammu, “PadhaiTumharDwar” Education at your doorstep in Bihar, “Upnayan Pahal” Portal and Education through Mobile Application, NCT's Campaign in Delhi “Buniyaad”, Kerala's own Educational TV Channel “Hi-Tech School Programme”, “e-Viddvan Portal” as



well as Online Certificate on Mental Health, etc. Various states have launched innovative mobile apps and portals to facilitate distance learning. The Government of Madhya Pradesh has launched the Top Parent App, a free mobile app that teaches parents of young children's child development knowledge and practices to help them form meaningful associations with their children. KHEL (Knowledge Hub for Electronic Learning) is a game-based application which is for the students of class I to class 3. The Government of Uttarakhand is using the "Sampark Bank App" through which primary school students can access animated videos, audios, worksheets, riddles, etc. The Government of Assam has launched the "BiswaVidya" Assam mobile app for classes 6 to 10. The Government of Bihar has launched the "Vidyavahini App" with e-books for students of classes 1 to 12". "Sikkim Edutech App" connects all schools of Sikkim under the State Education Department. An application named "Empower You Shiksha Darpan" has been launched to facilitate the evaluation of students in Tripura. The Government of Uttar Pradesh has launched the "Top Parent App" targeting children in the age group of 3 - 8 years.

Importance of Digital Educational Media

Various states of India are using WhatsApp as a medium of instruction and are motivating teach-

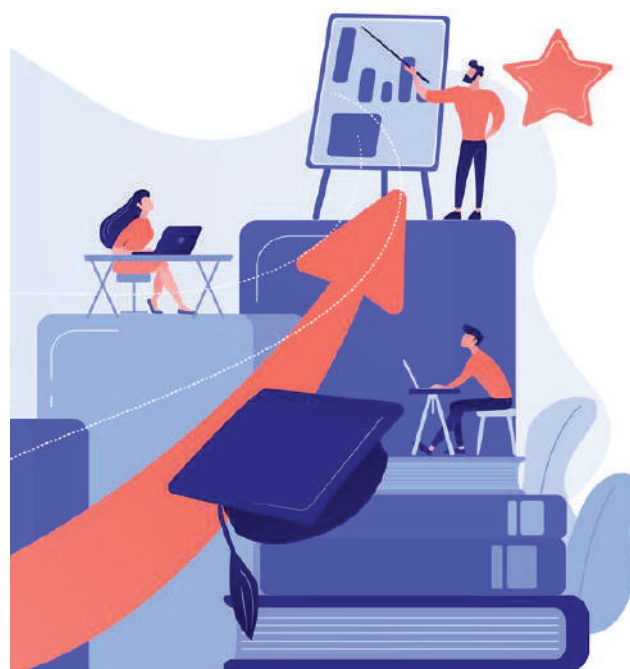
ers, parents, and students to stay connected. "Odisha Shiksha Sanjog" is a WhatsApp-based digital learning programme launched by the Government of Odisha to share e-content with class groups in a systematic manner. Online education is also being disseminated through WhatsApp in Punjab and Puducherry. Rajasthan has introduced "Hawamahal - Happy Saturday" using WhatsApp. Mission Prerna's e-Pathshala is a WhatsApp group of contacts between teachers and students in Uttar Pradesh. Himachal Pradesh has started three WhatsApp campaigns viz. "Corona", "Thodi Masti Thoda Study", and "Har Ghar Pathshala" in which the e-content has been curated by the states. Students solve their questions with the help of these apps and teachers give their feedback on it. A campaign for students with special needs has been named 'Hum Kisise Se Kum Nahi Mera Ghar Pathshala' wherein the educational resources are shared through WhatsApp and for which special teachers have been assigned.

Many states have had to adopt creative measures for specialized teaching and instruction with less technical forms without the Internet, e.g. in Arunachal Pradesh, students of primary classes have access to interesting radio talks in their mother tongue through All India Radio

(AIR), Itanagar. One such initiative of Puducherry is to telecast class lessons in the districts of Jharkhand through regional Doordarshan and available radio slot rooms. Manipur has introduced comic books for students in classes 3 to 5 to help them learn concepts in a fun way. EMBIBE Bangalore is collaborating with NGOs to provide online education to students even in low internet connectivity areas like Ladakh. Community engagement is one of the most difficult tasks at present, with local and individual resources becoming increasingly important. Popular facilities like quiz competitions are organized by the state of Haryana.

In order to meet the challenges of providing remote education, educational resources of NIOS and SWAYAM Prabha are designed keeping in mind both the children who are connected to the internet and those who have limited access to radio and TV. State initiatives to provide content through innovative channels are ensuring inclusive education, e.g. due to poor mobile connectivity and the non-availability of internet services, the Government of Chhattisgarh has introduced motor e-roving teachers, so that maximum teachers can connect with the students. The Government of Gujarat has launched Vanachan Abhiyaan and social psychological support programmes for children such as “Malo-Salamat e Humphalo” (Family Nest is Safe) to enhance their reading abilities. The Government of West Bengal has also started a special and dedicated toll-free helpline number for the students.

For ensuring inclusive education in remote areas where internet connectivity and electricity supply are not good, States and Union Territories have also distributed textbooks at the doorsteps of children. The states which have taken this initiative to reach out to the students include Odisha, Madhya Pradesh (under Efficiency Unnao Programme) Dadra and Nagar Haveli, and Daman and Diu, etc. Lakshadweep has distributed tablets equipped with e-content to the students. Nagaland has distributed study material to the students through DVD/Pen Drive at nominal cost. Jammu & Kashmir has distributed laptops to visu-



ally impaired learners and free tabs to students with Braille touch readability.

The digital education initiative is also becoming helpful for students preparing for competitive exams. Goa has partnered with Embibe, an Artificial Intelligence (AI) learning online platform for practice and testing of students preparing for entrance exams in the state. Karnataka has launched an exam preparation programme through Doordarshan and an SSLC exam preparation programme. Online practice tests with detailed analyses is available for government and government-aided students of Tamil Nadu preparing for the NEET exam. The educational content for higher classes keeping in view the need to meet the diverse needs of the states, ensuring complete control over the language as well as personality development has been prepared by NCT Delhi.

Digital Education, as also propounded by the National Education Policy 2020, is the way forward in the constantly changing world, and has transformed teaching and learning to make our students ready for the future possibilities and scenarios requiring technological and intellectual proficiency.

आज हम भारत की आज़ादी के 75 वर्ष पूरे होने के उपलक्ष्य पर आज़ादी का अमृत महोत्सव हर्षोल्लास से मना रहे हैं। इस गौरवपूर्ण उत्सव को हर घर तिरंगा अभियान ने और अधिक ख़ास एवं आनंदित बना दिया है। आज हमारा देश सैन्यबल, शिक्षा, खेल समेत तमाम मोर्चों पर तरक्की कर रहा है। परमाणु क्षमता-संपन्न हमारा देश भारत अंतरिक्ष विज्ञान के क्षेत्र में भी कई उपलब्धियां प्राप्त कर चुका है। और यह सफलता हमारे स्वतंत्रता सेनानियों के कई बलिदानों के परिणामस्वरूप संभव हो पायी है। सुभाष चंद्र बोस, मंगल पांडे, भगत सिंह, राजगुरु, सुखदेव जैसे और कई माटी के वीरों ने अपने प्राण त्यागे, तब जा कर हमें स्वयं को भारतीय कहलाने का सौभाग्य प्राप्त हुआ है। इसीलिए हमें हमारे स्वतंत्रता सेनानियों के बलिदान को किसी एक दिन नहीं बल्कि हमेशा याद करना चाहिए, जिनकी वजह से आज हम हर तरह से स्वतंत्र हैं।

हाँ, हम मुक्त हैं और पूरी तरह आज़ाद हैं, परन्तु हमें खुद को अपने देश के प्रति ज़िम्मेदारियों से आज़ाद नहीं समझना चाहिये। देश के ज़िम्मेदार नागरिक होने के नाते, हमें एक अच्छा समाज और उन्नत राष्ट्र बनाने में अपना पूर्ण योगदान देना है। इसके साथ ही, हमें अपनी आने वाली पीढ़ियों के बारे में भी विचार करना होगा ताकि हम उन्हें अंग्रेज़ी शासन के समय से चले आ रहे कानूनों, नियमों तथा मानसिकताओं से निजात दिला सकें। यह तो आप सभी जानते हैं कि न केवल आत्मनिर्भर भारत के निर्माण में, बल्कि आधुनिक, समृद्ध और खुशहाल भारत के निर्माण में भी शिक्षा का बहुत बड़ा महत्व है। आज़ादी से पूर्व, अंग्रेज़ों ने भारतीयों को इस उद्देश्य से शिक्षा देने के प्रावधान बनाये जिससे कि वे हमें पढ़े-लिखे क्लर्क बना सकें, और इस उद्देश्य की पूर्ति हेतु हमारी मातृभाषा एवं संस्कृति की बलि दे दी गयी। पर आज हमें बहुत खुशी है कि राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति 2020 के माध्यम से इन मूल विषयों पर विचार किया जा रहा है, जिससे कि भारत के विविध संस्कारों एवं संस्कृतियों को संरक्षित तथा परिपोषित किया जा सके। राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति 2020 के आने से भारत की नई नींव तैयार हो रही है। नए-नए कानूनों पर भी विचार किया जा रहा है जो हमारे देश की प्रगति के लिए अनिवार्य हैं, जैसे हमारे संविधान में निहित कानूनों में आज की समस्याओं को मद्देनज़र रखते हुए कई ऐसे बदलाव लाये गए हैं जिनसे जन-कल्याण संभव हो पाया है। ये परिवर्तन आवश्यक हैं ताकि राजनैतिक क्षेत्र लाभ कमाने के कार्यालय के बजाय जन-सेवा का कार्यालय बने, क्योंकि अंग्रेज़ी राज के समय से चले आ रहे बहुतेरे कानून तथा राजनैतिक एवं न्यायिक तंत्रों का फायदा उठाते हुए कुछ लोगों ने राजनीति को धन कमाने का ज़रिया बना कर लोगों को फ्रीबीस यानि रेवड़ी संस्कृति पर निर्भर बना दिया था। इन अवरोधों से पूर्णतः स्वतंत्रता पाने हेतु आवश्यक है कि उपयुक्त शासनप्रणाली तथा तंत्र का चयन कर उन पर अमल किया जाए।

इसके साथ ही यह आवश्यकता भी है कि सरकारी विश्वविद्यालयों को उचित संसाधन मुहैया कराये जाएँ ताकि उन्हें वैश्विक मानकों के अनुरूप विकसित करने में मदद की जा सके। इस सन्दर्भ में, मैं सरकार को बधाई देता हूँ कि राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति 2020 के रूप में भारत के शिक्षा तंत्र में परिवर्तन की एक पहल की गयी है। और आज हम गर्व से कह सकते हैं कि सी.ई.सी. राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति 2020 के अंतर्गत राष्ट्र-कल्याण की दिशा में भाषाई अवरोधों को लांघते हुए शिक्षार्थियों को 12 क्षेत्रीय भाषाओं में डिजिटल शैक्षिक कंटेंट प्रदान करने हेतु कार्यरत है। न केवल यह, बल्कि सी.ई.सी. मूक एवं बधिर दिव्यांग शिक्षार्थियों हेतु सांकेतिक भाषा में भी व्याख्यानों का निर्माण एवं प्रसारण कर रही है। आप सब से मैं यही आशा करता हूँ कि हमारे स्वतंत्र भारत को विश्वगुरु के रूप में आगे बढ़ाने हेतु आप सदैव इसी उत्साह से प्रयासरत रहेंगे।

The objective of the workshop was to orient the students of Community Science about online availability of learning resources. In the workshop, Ms. Supriya Sakamuri, Producer & MOOCs Coordinator, EMRC, EFLU, Hyderabad participated online as a Subject Expert and addressed the participants to elaborate upon the importance of SWAYAM MOOCs. Ms. Sakamuri provided relevant information to assist students' orientation with regard to SWAYAM MOOCs. She also deliberated extensively upon the registration process and use of online learning resources made available through MOOCs.

Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Dr. Narendra Singh Rathore, Maharana Pratap University of Agriculture and Technology, Udaipur and Dr. A. Sarada Devi, Former Dean, Home Science, ANGRAU & Former Emeritus Scientist (ICAR), Hyderabad also conducted sessions to provide enlightening insights upon SWAYAM MOOCs during the Workshop. About the Expert

Dr. Ritesh Bhardwaj is an alumnus of Jawaharlal Nehru University and the University of Delhi, from where he has received his M.Phil. and Ph.D., respectively. Currently, he is an Associate Professor at the Department of Political Science at Shyam Lal College (Eve.), University of Delhi. He has served in academia for more than 17 years and has published many research papers, book chapters, and books. He has also published an edited book on “Devising Policy Strategies for India, One Man, Multiple Facets”, and “An Introduction to Political Theory” for BAG students of IGNOU. He also organised national and international seminars funded by UGC and ICSSR and has presented numerous papers at national and international conferences.

Excerpt from the Lecture

The Indian Constitution has provided several rights as "Fundamental Rights" to the people, from articles 12 to 35 in Part III of the Indian Constitution. Fundamental rights are a very important topic in the Indian polity. These rights are enforceable through the courts, but on several occasions, the state government has found these rights as obstacles to its policies, particularly the policies regarding security of the state and policies for social welfare legislation. I have delivered this lecture in four parts. The first part dealt with the meaning of rights, human rights, and the importance of human rights. The second part discussed the concept of fundamental rights in the Indian Constitution. Part three has discussed the special features of fundamental rights and specific conditions when fundamental rights can abridge inconsistent law with fundamental rights. In part four, we talked about how fundamental rights are grouped and how the supreme court has ruled on fundamental rights.

Learning Objectives

- Explain what fundamental rights are and why they are important. Through examples and actual case studies, you can better comprehend the rights to equality, freedom, protection against exploitation, and freedom of religion, as well as other essential rights.
- Recognize the extent to which the state can impose restrictions on one's fundamental rights and justify the necessity of putting reasonable limits on the rights that have been granted or given.
- It's important to know that rights are not absolute and there could be some reasonable restrictions on fundamental rights. We all should be aware about these constitutional restrictions.
- Find examples of how the rights to freedom and equality have been violated in the society they live in.

Science writing for videos cannot be text-bookish yet it cannot take artistic liberty by diluting content. It is a tight rope.
