Circi- The Roman Circus was an adaptation of a Greek stadium, but, however, was used for chariot or horse races, while the Greek stadium was principally used for foot races and athletic sports.

Tablinum -Throne-room in Roman palaces.

Basilica- The hall for administering justice in Roman palaces.

Peristylum- A square garden surrounded by a colonnade in Roman palaces.

Triclinium- Banqueting hall in Roman palaces.

Lararium- Apartment for statues of the household gods in Roman palaces.
