Glossary

Emulsion paint: A coating material in which the medium is a dispersion of an organic binder in water.

Enamel paint: Pigmented organic polymeric binders that simulate the appearance, flow, smoothness and gloss of fused inorganic coatings.

Epoxy paint: A coating material based on an epoxy resin.

Flaking: Lifting of the coating materials from the substrate in the form of flakes or scales.

Flashing: The development of patches glossier than the general finish

Full gloss: The film of a coating material that, when dry, has a smooth almost mirror-like surface.
