social and environmental problems.

Captive Breeding

Raising plants or animals in zoos or other controlled conditions to produce stock for

subsequent release into the wild.

Chaotic Systems

Systems that exhibit variability, which may

not be necessarily random, yet whose complex patterns are not discernible over

a normal human time scale.
