Glossary

Aeration Tank

Following primary treatment, contaminants dissolved in sewage are consumed bymicroorganisms in large tanks that are supplied with the oxygen (air) necessaryfor the survival of the microorganisms.

Clarifier

A tank or basin in which sewage is held for a period of time, during which theheavier solids (referred to as sludge) settle to the bottom and any lightermaterials present (referred to as scum) float to the water surface. Used in bothprimary and secondary treatment.

Effluent

The treated, cleaned discharge from sewage treatment plants.

Thickening

A process used to increase the solids content of waste activated sludge byremoving a portion of the water.

Sewage

The liquid waste products of domestic, industrial, agricultural and manufacturingactivities directed to the sanitary sewer system.
