Object = anything that can be seen and touched, thing, article, item, piece, gadget, entity, etc.

System = set of things working together as parts of a mechanism, interconnecting network, a complex whole, structure, order.

Measurable human interaction as in architectural blueprints, engineering drawings, business processes, circuit diagrams, sewing pattern, products, etc.
