

## **Glossary**

### **Circulation**

The movement to and fro or around something, especially that of fluid in a closed system. An orderly movement through a circuit

### **Periphery**

The outer limits or edge of an area or object. the external boundary of any surface or area. the edge or outskirts, as of a city or urban area.

### **Roman Military Settlement**

The ideal enforced a linear plan for a camp or fort: a square for camps to contain one legion or smaller unit, a rectangle for two legions.

### **Circus**

A rounded open space in a town or city where several streets converge.

### **Arterial Roads**

An **arterial road** or **arterial** thoroughfare is a high-capacity urban **road**. The primary function of an **arterial road** is to deliver traffic from collector **roads** to freeways or expressways, and between urban centres at the highest level of service possible.
