Glossary

Vernacular Architecture - is a term used to categorize methods of construction which use locally available resources and traditions to address local needs.

Regional Modernism - a style prevalent in South Asia pioneered by Geoffrey Bawa has concepts from the regional vernacular played with modernism.

Domestic Vernacular Architecture - Comprises of the buildings designed for living (activity participated by the entire family such as eating, sitting, sleeping, storage etc.) and the ancillary buildings such as wash area, kitchens, stores etc.
