Victorian architecture –

Victorian architecture is a style of architecture originated to commemorate Queen Victoria. It was a hotchpotch of early European styles mixed with the introduction of Middle East and Asian influences

Mansard roof -

A roof with two slopes, and often it is flat on top

Dormer -

Dormer is a window that sticks out from the roof that has a roof of its own.

Entablature -

The upper part of a wall or story

Cornice -

The upper part of a wall or story

Turret –

Turret is a small, skinny tower usually at the corner of a building.
