

## **Glossary**

**Taaq** - The distance between two brick piers normally around 3-4 ft was known as a Taaq and could either be used for windows or doors.

**Dhaaji Dewari** – construction method based on a braced timber framed structural system, in which normally 4-9 inch thick brick or stone masonry is, used to infill the gaps.

**Dhungas** – boat houses of vernacular architecture of Kashmir.

**Dub** – bay window in dwelling units of Kashmir.

**Kani** – the second floor or attic space in a dwelling unit.

**Morakh patt** – broad eaves that protect the Dub.
