## Glossary

**Thatchu Sasthram** – was a script of traditional guidelines that listed he since of carpentry and vasthu sasthra

**Thai Kottaram** – was the Mothers palace, the main part of palace that was centrally located

**Nataksala** – halls were dedicated for the purpose of dance and performance and were called Nataksala

**Vashtu Sasthra** – was set of building and construction guidelines based on climate and traditional guidelines

**Koothambalam** – are spaces in a temple that were meant to be for performance and dances

**Mannarasala** – the Kings council, the part of the palace where the King conducted his courtly proceedings

**Theckee Kottaram** – is called as the southern palace

**Nalukettu** – is a courtyard which forms main part of a planning principle in Kerala architecture
