## Glossary

**Baseline situation:** Existing environmental situation or condition in the absence of the activity. To measure an impact, we must know what the baseline situation is.

**Derelict land**: Land so damaged by industrial or other development that it is incapable of beneficial use without treatment. Land that is not in a stable or productive condition

**EIA:** An environmental impact assessment (EIA) is an analytical process that systematically examines the possible environmental consequences of the implementation of projects, programmes and policies.

**Impact :** A deviation (a change) from the <u>baseline situation</u> that is caused by the <u>activity</u>

**Mitigation:** Implementation of measures designed to reduce the undesirable effects of a proposed action on the environment

**Reclamation:** Returning disturbed lands to a form in which the lands may be of beneficial use

**Subsidence**: Land subsidence is the lowering of the ground surface from changes that take place underground
