

## **Glossary**

### **Accessibility:**

Available means of communications i.e. roads, rail, etc.

### **Base Map:**

Map serving as the foundation for subsequent planning showing all physical features and existing land use/ built up area/ city.

### **Residential Land Use:**

The land category in development or layout plan devoted to residential activity which may be sub-divided into zones/ clusters by nature, intensity, type, ownership.

### **Urban Agglomeration:**

In the study of human settlements, an **urban agglomeration** is an extended city or town area comprising the built-up area of a central place (usually a municipality) and any suburbs linked by continuous **urban** area.

### **Metropolis:**

any large, busy city; the chief, and sometimes capital, city of a country, state, or region; a central or principal place, as of some activity; the mother city or parent state of a colony, especially of an ancient Greek colony; the chief see of an ecclesiastical province.

### **Anthropos:**

**Anthropos** is Greek for man, often translated as Son of man in New Testament. **Anthropos** may also refer to: **Anthropos**, in Gnosticism, the first human being, also referred to as Adamas or Geradamas.
