

Summary

This session would lend you information on the key factors that help choosing a site. It begins with what a site analysis is and moves on to explain the physical characteristics of the site including location, climatic and other factors. It talks about parameters like vistas, proximity, neighborhood aspects and orientation to make a user understand on how to choose the best of locations offered. Then different housing typologies in urban and rural are detailed out including free standing dwelling units, single dwelling, apartment type, row house, housing cooperative, mud house, potters and weaver's house. This explains the spatial characteristic of each typology and establishes how a dwelling unit is social as well as economically attached to the user groups.
