

Summary

This session would lend you information four different housing projects namely: Belapur housing, Yerwada housing project, Tsunami housing and Kanchenjunga. Each of the design case study are unique in an aspect to integrate an aspect of design and urbanism in to the planning of the same. Belapur demonstrates how high density housing can be achieved in a low-rise typology, while including open to sky spaces and services, like schools, that the community requires. Likewise the concept incremental Housing Strategy intended to allow districts to improve organically without uprooting communities is demonstrated in Yerwada housing project. The chapter concludes with Kanchenjunga that demonstrates the efficiency achieved in vertical zoning and how a massing works with different climatic aspects.
