## Glossary

- Cognitive: Concerned with the act or process of knowing, perceiving, etc.
- **Affective**: Relating to moods, feelings, and attitudes
- Psychomotor: Relating to the origination of movement in conscious mental activity.
- **Instinct**: An innate, typically fixed pattern of behavior in response to certain stimuli
- **Progressive**: Happening or developing gradually or in stages
- Obnoxious: Highly objectionable or offensive
- **Sublimate**: To express a desire or feeling by changing it into a form that is socially acceptable
- Stimuli: Something that can elicit or evoke a physiological response
- **Implication:** The action or state of being involved in something.
