**Equipment, Playing Conditions and Officials in Table Tennis**

**F.A.Q's**

**Question 1 What are the things considered in playing clothing?**

**Answer** Playing clothing shall consist of a short-sleeveless shirt and shorts or skirts or one-part sports outfits, socks and playing shoes; other garments; such as part or all of a track suit, shall not be worn during play except with the permission of the referee.

**Question 2 What is playing space?**

**Answer** The playing space shall be rectangular and not less than 14m long, 7 m wide and 5 m high, but the 4 corners may be covered by surrounds of not more than 1.5m length.

**Question 3 what equipment and fittings are to be considered as part of each playing area.**

**Answer** The table including the net assembly, printed numbers identifying the table, umpires tables and chairs, score indicators, towel and ball boxes, surrounds, flooring, boards on the surrounds indicating the names of players or Associations and small technical equipment which shall be fitted in a way that does not affect play.

**Question 4 How the racket control centre test rackets?**

**Answer** The racket control centre test rackets, according to the policy and procedure established by the Executive committee on recommendation of the equipment committee and Umpires and Refrees committee, to ensure that rackets abide by all ITTF regulations including, but not limited to, racket covering thickness, flatness, flatness and presence of harmful volatile substances.

**Question 5. What is the role of Referee in Table-Tennis Match?**

**Answer** For each competition as a whole a referee shall be appointed and his or her identity and location shall be made known to the participants and, where appropriate to the team captains.
