



Summary

The National Curriculum Framework for Teacher Education (2009) voices the need and importance of professionally trained teacher educators (TEs). The quality of teacher educators is central to the quality of teacher education and hence, professional preparation of teachers. Further, teachers are the most important factor that determines the quality of school education.
