

Glossary

Professional: A person engaged in a specified activity, especially a sport, as a main paid occupation rather than as a pastime.

Malnutrition: Lack of proper nutrition, caused by not having enough to eat, not eating enough of the right things, or being unable to use the food that one does eat.

Communist: A person who supports or believes in the principles of communism.

Comradeship: The company and friendship of others with common aims.

Pedagogical: Relating to, or befitting a teacher or education.

Epistemology: The philosophical theory of knowledge

Therapeutic: Tending to cure or restore to health

Dissemination: The opening of a subject to widespread discussion and debate

Legitimacy: Lawfulness by virtue of being authorized or in accordance with law
