Multilateral type of funding: The term multilateral means that funding comes from multiple governments as well as from non-governmental sources.

Bilateral type of funding: Bilateral agencies are governmental agencies in a single country which provide aid to developing countries.

Welfare: A socio-politico and economic environment which is characterised by pro-people policy governance.

Bottom-up paradigm: It refers to a policy framework where emphasis is given to grassroots for fuller and wider developmental governance.
