Administration: Relating to the management of an organisation.

Minister: High officer of state entrusted with the management of governmental activities.

Welfare: Government programme for poor or unemployed people that helps pay for their needs.

Medicine: Science that deals with preventing, caring and treating diseases.

Homeopathy: Medical practice that treats diseases by the administration of minute doses.

Department: One of the major parts of a company, government or organisation.

Naturopathy: Treatment of disease using natural agents.

Cabinet: A group of people who give advice to the leader of a government.

Legislation: A law or set of laws made by a govt.
