GLOSSARY:

Sky diving: It is an adventure sport which includes jumping off an aircraft and performing acrobatic maneuvers in the air under free fall before landing by a parachute.

Community: A community is a small or large social unit or a group of people who have something in common, such as norms, religion, values or identity.

Recreational Agencies: Recreation facilities, activities and programs are being provided by various agencies, which were mainly created to meet the existing demands for the various types of leisure time opportunities. The agencies have their own scope, objectives and field of activities.

Picnics: A picnic is not considered as pure recreation, it is an excursion at which a meal is eaten outdoors, ideally taking place in a scenic landscape such as a park, beside a lake or with an interesting view possibly at a public event, basically it refers to a meal out-of doors in the midst of scenic beauty.

Infrastructure: Infrastructure refers to the fundamental facilities and systems serving a country, city, area, etc. including the services and facilities necessary for its economy to function.

Botanical Garden: A garden for the exhibition and scientific study of collected, growing plants, usually in association with greenhouses, herbariums, laboratories, etc. also called botanic garden.

Youth Festivals: Generally theme based, youth festivals are typically events with a wide variety of activities for young people. The common festival themes include art, music, dance, film, games and academics. The main purpose of these festivals is to break the monotony and provide opportunities to the organizers and the participants as well.

Leadership: Leadership is the activity of leading a group of people or an organization or the ability to establish a clear vision; sharing that vision with others so that they follow willingly; the act of providing the information, knowledge and methods to realize that vision and coordinating and balancing the conflicting interests of all members and stakeholders.

Athletics: Athletics comprises track and field events, which includes running races and various competitions in jumping, throwing and putting.

Hiking: Hiking is going for long, vigorous walk, usually on trails (footpaths), in the countryside, the term is usually preferred in Canada and the US and is a popular adventure activity mostly among youth and people looking for an escape from their daily routine.
