

## **GLOSSARY:**

**Accommodation:** Accommodation refers to a place to live, it may be a tent, a tree-house, room or group of rooms or building. It is a convenient arrangement or a settlement in which someone lives or may live.

**Camp leadership:** Camp leadership refers to leadership or the action of leading an individual or group of individuals in the camp setting for specific activities planned in the camp. It may also refer to preparing leaders through camping.

**Campers:** Individual or people who spend a holiday in a tent or holiday camp, or people who reside in tented accommodation for a specific period of time while attending a camp for any specific theme or activity.

**Camping:** An increasingly popular outdoor recreation activity among children, youth and even adults, camping involves staying away from home in a shelter such as a tent, a caravan or a motorhome. For an activity to be considered as camping one has to spend at least one night in the camping area.

**Diligence:** The act of constant and earnest effort to accomplish what is undertaken through persistent exertion of body or mind.

**Environment:** Comprises the surroundings or conditions in which a person, animal or plant lives and operates and the recreation activities are conducted.

**Ethics:** Comprises the moral principles that govern a person's behaviour or the conducting of an activity.

**First aid:** First aid is the assistance given to any person suffering a sudden illness or injury, with care provided to preserve life, prevent the condition from worsening and/or to promote recovery.

**Foresightedness:** The ability or action of the individual of imagining or anticipating what might happen in the immediate future by analyzing the recent course of activities or actions.

**Sanitation:** Sanitation is a means for promoting hygiene through the prevention of human contact with hazards of wastes especially faeces, by proper treatment and disposal of the waste, often mixed into wastewater.
