GLOSSARY:

Activity: Something to make a person physically busy.

Awards: Something given especially a reward for merit or prize.

Discipline: Training aimed at improving physical powers, strengthening self-control, producing obedience etc.

Finance: To provide money or fund for a particular purpose.

Leadership: A person in-charge or responsible for leading a group.

Operation: To work or make something work or put into action.

Organizing: To arrange people, things etc. into effective working whole.

Planning: To make preparation or decide in advance what is to be done.

Publicity: The bringing out of something to the attention of the public by means of advertising, news items etc.

Safety: Not likely to come to harm, to avoid risks.
