

## Glossary

**i) Simulation:** Simulation is defined as role playing in which the process of teaching is enacted in an artificial situation with the objective of developing or practicing a specific skill of teaching communication.

**ii) Simulated teaching:** Simulated teaching is a training technique like micro teaching where the technique is used to change behaviour of trainees and in education, it is used before the actual practice teaching.

**iii) Micro teaching:** Micro teaching is a teacher-training concept that can be applied at various pre-service and in-service stages in the professional development of teachers.

**iv) Socio drama:** Socio drama consists of unprepared, unrehearsed dramatization dealing with some problems in personal relations.

**v) Role play:** Role playing is a form of unrehearsed, unprepared dramatization experience which is especially effective when the role has an immediate carry-over into real life situations.
