Glossary

1) **Non-verbal communication**: Non-verbal communication refers to body language that people express.

2) **Verbal Communication**: Verbal communication means anything that a teacher or student speaks aloud.

3) **Barriers**: Barriers can be any form of disturbance that disrupts the free and successful interchange of ideas and message between the sender and the receiver.

4) **Classroom Communication**: Every action of the teacher, the directions being given by the teacher, be it his lecturing, asking questions, recapitulating, assignment, homework etc. all continuously influence the learner and thus is included in classroom communication.

5) Interpersonal Communication: Interpersonal communication means communication between at least few people who interact face to face like a telephone.
