Glossary

- 1. Projected teaching aid: They are pictures shown upon a screen by use of a certain type of machine.
- 2. Non-projected teaching aid: Teaching aids which are used without any projection.
- 3. Graphic aid: Any image or visual representation that assist the reader in understanding the text which accompanies the visual aid.
- 4. Display board: A board shaped material that is rigid and strong enough to stand on its own, and generally used paper or other materials affixed to it.
- 5. Three dimensional aids: Actual objects or their scale down or blown up replicas as an aid for instruction.
