1. What do you understand by contrived experiences?

Ans: It is the second stage in Edgar Dale's Cone of Experience next to direct purposeful experiences where representative models and mock-ups of reality are being used in order to provide an experience that are close to reality. This level is very practical and it makes learning experience more accessible to the learner. In this stage, it provides more concrete experiences, even if not as concrete as direct experiences, that allows visualization that fosters better understanding of the concept.

2. State the importance of the Cone of Experience.

Ans: The Cone charts the average retention rate for various methods of teaching. The further one progresses down the Cone, the greater the learning and the more information is likely to be retained.

3. Why is Edgar Dale's Cone effective?
