Glossary

1. **Projected teaching aid:** They are pictures shown upon a screen by use of a certain type of machine.

2. Non-projected teaching aid: Teaching aids which are used without any projection.

3. Chart: A chart is a non-projected visual teaching aid with diagrammatic representation of a system, process and historical sequence of event.

4. Chalk Board: It is a simple non-projected and universally used visual teaching aid which comprises a board and a chalk piece.

5. **Overhead projector:** It is a simple audio-visual projecting device that can project a chart, a diagram, a map, a table or anything written on transparent plates upon a screen or the white wall before students in a class.
