Each letter of "leadership" can be abbreviated as:

- L: Loyalty
- **E**: Enthusiasm, Endurance, Engaging personality.
- **A**: Alertness, Adjustment, Ability to coordinate activities.
- **D**: Discipline, Dutifulness, Dependability, desire to help others.
- **E**: Energetic, Earnestness.
- **R**: Reliability, Right-thinking and Right judgement.
- **S**: Sincerity, Sympathy, Self control, Sacrifice, super motor capacity.
- **H**: Health, Honey, Humour.
- I: Intelligent, Industriousness, Impartiality, Interest in teaching
- **P**: Patience, Perseverance, Personality, Physical skill, Public relation.

Element

Some effective elements of students' leadership are:

- 1. **Clarity of vision**: Clarity of vision is a clear picture. Whether we answer the question for ourselves as student leaders, for a team, a division, or an organization, we need to envision an outcome as a future reality. A student leader has a vision and a conviction that a dream can be achieved. He/she inspires the power and the energy to get it done.
- 2. **Courage**: Courage is very essence of being authentic and developing trust in you and you're taking the students- vitally important to a long-term and sustainable success of any business and leader. Courage enables the speed being sought- sharing what we really think and feel and listening as others share with us. Speed of respond, to take action to make decisions, to create value and to engage in constructive and meaningful ways with all the critical stakeholders in their leadership carrier and personal lives.
- 3. **Value creation**: College is the perfect place to acquire and hone the skills that are necessary for success in the post graduate gauntlet, but a skill that cannot come from classroom experience alone is leadership which naturally means value creation. Communication constitutes a very important function of management, since the student leader accomplish very little without it. Communication is the means by which the behaviour of the subordinates is modified and change is effected in their actions communication is always a two way process. It involves two individuals, a sender and a receiver. It refers to exchange of ideas, feelings emotions and knowledge and information between two or more persons. Nothing happens in management till communication takes place at different levels appropriately.

Significance of student's leadership-

- 8. Student leader should be selected according to his/her capability.
- 9. Student's selections can be done with the help of teachers and students.
- 10. According to administrative view a student leader should be selected amongst good students.
