**Q1.** What is Organization?

Ans:- Organization is to bring together or form as a whole or combination for a common objective. It refers to process of setting up things or providing an orderly set-up of things.

Ans:- The functions of Sports Project Development Area (SPDA) are to promote sports infrastructure all over the country by giving grants-in-aid to voluntary organizations, State Sports Councils, State government etc.
