Antibiotics: A medicine that inhabits the growth of or destroy microorganism.

Abduction: The movement of a limb or other part away from the midline of the body

Extension: A part that is added to something to enlarge or prolong it.

Fungicide: A chemical that destroys fungus.

Flexion: The action of bending or the condition of being bent.

Hygiene: The science of health, its promotion and preservation.

Osteoporosis: A disease in which the bones become extremely porous and are subject to fracture.

Vaccination: Inoculation with a vaccine in order to protect from a particular disease or strain of disease.
