1. What is handball, and who recognized the game?

Ans:- Handball is a team sport in which two teams of several players each pass a ball using their hands with the aim of throwing it into the goal of the other team. It is recognized by the International Olympic Association.

2. How many players are there in a handball team?

Ans:- A team consists of up to 14 players. No more than 7 players may be present on the court at the same time. The remaining players are substitutes.

3. What is the weight and circumference of a handball for female youth and male youth?

Ans: The weight and circumference of a handball for female youth (age 8 to 14) and male youth (age 8 to 12) is 50-52cm and 290-330g (IHF Size 1).

4. What is the responsibility of a timekeeper?

Ans:- The timekeeper has the main responsibility for the playing time, the time-outs, and the suspension time of suspended players.

5. From where the throw-in is taken in a handball court?

Ans: The throw-in is taken from the spot where the ball crossed the sideline, or if it crossed the endline, from the nearest corner.

6. What is the responsibility of a scorekeeper?

Ans:- The scorekeeper has the main responsibility for the team score sheet, the entering of players who arrive after the game has started, and the entering of players who are not entitled to participate.

7. For what reason is a timeout obligatory in a handball game?

Ans:- 1. A time-out is obligatory when:

- a) A 2-minute suspension or disqualification is given;
- b) A team time-out is granted;

8. What is the duration of a handball match?

Ans:- A standard match consists of two periods of 30 minutes, and the team that scores more goals wins.

9. How many referees are there in a handball game?

Ans:- There are two referees, a court referee and a goal line referee. Referees have complete authority. Their decisions are final.
