

SUMMARY

The ball is in play from the last moment at which it is stationary on the palm of the free hand before being internationally projected in service until it touches anything other than the playing surface, the net assembly, the racket held in the racket hand or the racket hand below the wrist, or until is otherwise decide a let or a point. A player obstructs the ball if he or anything he wears or carries, touches it in play when it is travelling towards the playing surface and not having touches his court since fast being struck by his opponent.

The umpire is the person appointed to decide the results of each rally.
