- 1. Decelerate:- To cause (something) to happen more slowly.
- 2. Drag:- Someone or something that is boring, annoying, or disappointing.
- 3. Edge:- The part of a blade that cuts.

- 5. Obscure:- Difficult or impossible to know completely and with certainty.

- 9. Split:- To separate or divide into parts or droops.
