1. What is the meaning of badminton?
Ans:- Badminton is a racquet sport played using racquets to hit a shuttlecock across a net. Although it may be played with larger teams, the most common forms of the game are “singles and doubles”.
2. What are the overall dimensions of a badminton court?
Ans:- The overall dimension of a badminton court is 20 feet by 44 feet.
3. What is the height of post from the ground?
Ans:- The height of the posts from the ground is 1.55 meters in height.
4. What is the weight of the shuttle?
Ans:- The weight of the shuttle shall be from 4.74 to 5.50 grams.
5. What is the length of the shuttle?
Ans:- The length of the shuttle shall be between 62 mm to 70 mm.
6. What is the overall length and width of a badminton racket?
Ans:- The overall length of a badminton racket is not exceeding 680 mm and 230 mm in width consisting of the main parts.
7. How many players are there in single and double match?
Ans:- In singles there are 2 players and in doubles there are 4 players.
8. What is the depth and wide of the net?
Ans:- The net shall be 760 mm in depth and at least 6.1 meters wide.
9. What type of material is the shuttle made of?
Ans:- The shuttle is made of natural and / or synthetic materials
10. How many feathers are there in a badminton shuttle?
Ans:- There are 16 feathers in a badminton shuttle.
