Glossary

- Working class: The working class are those minimally educated people who engage in "manual labor" with little or no prestige.
- **Middle class:** The middle class is a <u>class</u> of people in the middle of a social hierarchy. In <u>Weber an</u> socio-economic terms, the middle class is the broad group of people in contemporary society who fall socio-economically between the <u>working class</u> and <u>upper class</u>.
- **Social class:** Social class refers to a group of people with similar levels of wealth, influence, and status.
