Glossary

- **Momentum Ignition:** This strategy aims to cause a spike in the price of a stock by using a series of trades with the motive of attracting other algorithm traders to also trade that stock.
- **Pair Trading:** Pair Trading is a market neutral strategy where two highly co-related instruments are bought and sold together when there is a certain degree of deviation in their co-relation.
- **FIIIs,** an abbreviation used for Foreign Institutional Investors, are the investors that pool their money to invest in the assets of the country situated abroad. It is a tool for making quick money for the investors. Institutional investors are companies that invest money in the financial markets in the country based outside the investor country.
