Summary

It is clear that the presence of mycotoxins in poultry feed can result in significant economic losses for the poultry producer. The world demand for poultry keeps rising despite high feed consumption and production prices. Demands for quality poultry are directly linked to demands for quality feed. As the effects of mycotoxins in poultry are often subclinical, they are frequently overlooked by farm technicians. Mycotoxin risk management is crucial to eliminate the effect of fungal toxins and their toxicity and should be carried out on a continuous basis through a proper mycotoxin risk management tool which uses different strategies.
