Glossary

<u>fugitive</u>: Pigments that are not permanent are called <u>fugitive</u>. Fugitive pigments fade over time, or with exposure to light, while some eventually blacken

biological pigment: the pigment whose source from biological matter.

<u>visible light</u>: White light is a roughly equal mixture of the entire spectrum of visible light with a <u>wavelength</u> in a range from about 375 or 400 <u>nanometers</u> to about 760 or 780 nm.

synthetic pigment: the pigment which is obtained from synthesis.

"trigeminal senses", which detect chemical <u>irritants</u> in the <u>mouth</u> and <u>throat</u> as well as temperature and texture,
