- A bar chart or bar diagram is a chart with rectangular bars, with their lengths proportional to the values that they represent. The bars can be plotted vertically or horizontally.
- Types of Bar Chart:
 - Horizontal bar: The data represented as a bar chart in a horizontal fashion, is called as the horizontal bar chart.
 - Vertical bar: The data represented as a bar chart in a vertical fashion, is called as the vertical bar chart.
 - Multiple bar: When two or more interrelated series of data are depicted by a bar chart, such a diagram is known as a 'multiple bar diagram'.
 - Sub-divided or component bar: This diagram will show subdivisions or components in a single bar.
