1. **Interrelate**  
Interrelate refers to connected to one other or related to one other.
2. **Precursor**  
It can be a person or thing that comes before another of the same kind.
3. **Predecessor**  
A person who held a job or office before the current holder; a thing that has been followed or replaced by another.
4. **Depicted**  
Depict refers to show or represent by a drawing, painting, or other art form; portray in words or to describe.
5. **Deterministic**  
It's the doctrine that all events and actions are ultimately determined by causes regarded as external to the will.
6. **Critical path**  
It is a longest sequence of activities in a project plan which must be completed on time for the project to complete on due date.
7. **Parameters**  
It's a measurable or quantifiable characteristic of a system.
8. **Slack**  
Slack means not taut or held tightly in position; loose.
9. **Attributes**  
It's a quality or feature regarded as characteristic or inherent.
10. **Appropriately**  
It's a term used for suitable or proper.
11. **Scenarios**  
A sequence of events especially when imagined; especially, an account or synopsis of a possible course of action or events.
12. **Tracking**  
The action of tracking someone or something; the maintenance of a constant difference in frequency between two or more connected circuits or components.

The state of being responsible for something, especially by law; an obligation that legally binds an individual or company to settle a debt.

Be received by someone in regular or increasing amounts over time; accumulate or receive.

An instrument or device for measuring the magnitude, amount, or contents of something, typically with a visual display of such information.
