

Glossary

1. Fertility

In demography, fertility indicates the product or output of reproduction, rather than the ability to have children.

2. Reproduction

The action or process of reproducing; process of child birth.

3. Gross

It means unattractively large or bloated.

4. Index

An alphabetical list of names, subjects; an indicator, sign or measure of something.

5. Mortality

Death, especially on large scale; the number of death in a given area.

6. Computing

Calculating a figure or amount to make sense.

7. Inflates

It means expand or cause to expand; increase by large or excessive amount.

8. Enumeration

Mention one by one; establish the number.

9. Approximate

Fairly accurate but not totally precise; almost correct.

10. Assumption

A thing that is assumed as true; a thing is considered as fact for particular action.

11. Summation

The process of adding things together; sum total.

12. Registration

The action or process of registering into official list or record.

13. Inadequate

It means lacking the quality or quantity required; insufficient.

14. Hypothesis

It means proposed explanation made on the basis of limited evidence as a starting point for further investigation.

15. Replenishment

It means fill up again; restore to a former level or condition.
