1. **Analysis**
The separation of an intellectual or material whole into its constituent parts for individual study.
2. **Biometry**
It is the application of statistical analysis to biological data.
3. **Census**
It is an official periodic count of a population including such information as sex, age, occupation, etc.
4. **Conventional**
Based on or in accordance with what is generally done or believed.
5. **Demography**
Demography is the statistical study of human populations and sub-populations.
6. **Estimate**
It is an approximate calculation of quantity or degree or worth.
7. **Infrastructure**
It is an underlying base or foundation especially for an organization or system.
8. **Legitimate**
It is being accordance with established or accepted patterns and standards.
9. **Migration**
It is the act or an instance of migrating.
10. **Morbidity**
It is the rate of incidence of a disease.
11. **Population**
The set of individuals, items, or data from which a statistical sample is taken.
12. **Reliability**
Capable of being relied on.
